All campers participate in flag ceremonies, s'mores, campfires, skits and singing.

Program Activities offered by age group:

- 1st thru 3rd grade: mountain biking, nature, crafts, swimming & outdoor cooking
- 4th thru 6th grade: archery, nature, crafts, swimming
- 7th thru 12th grade: canoeing, archery, nature, crafts, swimming

Horseback riding is offered to 4th – 6th graders for an additional fee of \$50 ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. 30 riders can be accommodated Saturday. Additional rides can be scheduled for Friday or Sunday. Full payment of the \$50 per rider must be paid with registration deposit to hold spot.

CHAPERONES must accompany campers attending Wild Girls. One adult may chaperone more than one camper. Chaperones must register and pay the reduced Chaperone fee.
