#### Dear Girl Scout Troop Leader,

- 1. Re-registration
  - a. Renew at least 70% of the girls in your troop.
- 2. Financial Reports
  - a. Submit a completed financial report to council.
- 3. Submit an Early Bird Patch Order Form.

#### Why Early Bird your troop?

- Your troop will be eligible to attend the Early Bird Campout at Chukchansi Park
- Every girl re-registered by June 30 gets a free Early Bird patch
- Higher Cookie Proceeds
- Honor Troop Eligibility







### How do I renew my troop?

Renewing your troop is fast and easy! Follow these instructions to renew your troop. If you have any questions, call Customer Care at 1-800-490-8653.

1. Login to your MyGS account from the council website at <a href="https://www.girlscoutsccs.org">www.girlscoutsccs.org</a>.



- 2. Choose "Member Profile".
- 3. Go to the "Troops" tab.





4. Set all renewing girls to "Renew Now". Set all girls who are unsure about renewing to "I'll Decide Later". Set all girls NOT continuing with the troop to "Don't Renew". Click Continue. NOTE: Setting girls to "Don't Renew" will remove the ability for that girl to renew into the troop. If you have girls who are unsure about renewing, set them to "I'll Decide Later". This will give you the ability to renew those girls at a later date.

# **Troop/SU Financial Reports**

Annual Troop/SU Financial reports are due to council by June 30, 2019. For a financial report to be considered complete, the troop/SU must submit:

- 1. All 12 bank statements from the reporting period
- 2. All receipts from the reporting period
- 3. Detailed cash log and summary spreadsheet (located on the Forms tab of our website)

Please submit all documents to <u>financials@girlscoutsccs.org</u>. We are NOT taking submissions through the Volunteer Toolkit Finance Tab.

Troops that do not submit a completed report to council by June 30, 2019 are out of compliance with council policies and procedures and will not be considered in good standing. Failure to submit a completed Troop/SU financial report by June 30, 2019 will affect the troop's eligibility to participate in the Fall Product and Cookie Programs, troop trips, fundraising activities, and Early Bird Campout.

\*\*New this year\*\* Troops that do not submit a completed financial report by June 30, 2019 will receive lower proceeds for the Fall Product and Cookie Programs. *Please see page 7 for more details.* 

### **Honor Troop**

#### **Honor Troop is back!**

If your troop would like to achieve Honor Troop status for the 2019/2020 membership year, the troop must renew 70% of the girls AND submit a completed financial report by June 30, 2019. Additional details regarding Honor Troop requirements will be sent to troops no later than August 1, 2019.

### What is Honor Troop?

Honor Troop is a distinction given to troops that are active within Girl Scouting and are in good standing at the Council level. This includes renewal and financials reports, as well as, participating in Girl Scout activities and traditions within the period of that membership year.



### **Cookie Proceeds**

New this year: Fall Product Program and Cookie Program base Troop Proceeds will be based on Early Bird troop registration, and successful submission of completed troop financial reports.
