Requirements to be considered a Legacy Troop:



- Complete Back to Troop Update
- Leaders have completed all three Learn to Lead trainings
- Host a Grow Your Troop recruitment with staff at least once per year
- 75% Early Bird Renewal Rate
- Complete Troop Financials by June 30th
- Participation in Fall and Cookie Product Programs
- Complete a service project or represent GSCCS in your community
- Plus One of the following engagement activities:
 - Host a Sister Troop Meeting
 - Host or Participate in a Bridging Ceremony
 - Attend a GSCCS Signature Event*
