New wording as follows:

2. In the event that charter revocation or non-issuance is contemplated, notice of reason will be provided to the council along with a reasonable time period for response. A time and location will be provided where the council can review and discuss the issue(s) with a team representing the National Board an ad-hoc committee of 3 Council CEOs, 3 Council Board Chairs, 3 National Delegates selected from a representation of councils, and 3 National Board Members.

| 3. Following the meeting the National Board will in its sole discretion under the advisement of the adhoc committee will take action that it deems appropriate including revocation or non-issuance and will communicate the action to the council with follow-up measures. The decision of the National Board will be final. Having considered the advisement of the ad hoc committee, the decision of the National Board will be final. | | |
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REASONS:

- 1. What is the issue the discussion topic or proposal is trying to address?
- 2. Are there other ways to address this issue?
- 3. How does this proposal improve Movement governance or policy? OR How does this discussion topic inform Movement strategy?
- 4. Does this agenda item have Movement-wide significance? Does it apply to all councils?

- 1. There currently is no defined procedure for a council facing charter revocation to appeal or create an improvement plan to salvage their charter if the National Board deems revocation necessary. It is our hope that an ad-hoc committee could provide peer-to-peer collaborative environment to help the affected council retain their charter or agree to an improvement plan.
- 2. Yes, by Constitutional Amendment (re: our 2023 proposal)
- 3. By removing the vague "team representing the National Board" with a defined committee structure, it is our hope that the process of revoking a council charter be more collaborative and restorative, potentially saving a council's charter
- 4. Yes, and yes
